Tips Families can use to help students do better in school.

Good character originates at home. Here's how you can help your child grow into a person of good character.

- Insist on Honesty. If a child breaks a rule and then lies about it, consider two consequences. One for breaking the rule and one for the lie.
- Praise positive behavior if your child demonstrates good character, praise him/her! Your reinforcement will encourage him/her to continue that behavior.
- Be a strong role model. Live up to the values you're promoting.

SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Al-Huda dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, instills discipline, prevent disruption, and teach respect. Student should be dressed and groomed in a manner that is clean and neat and that will not be a health or safety hazard to themselves or others.

1. Students are expected to be in uniform everyday.
2. Upkeep of the uniform is the responsibility of the student and parents.
3. Teachers and administration should be conducting uniform checks.

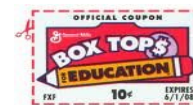
➤ KG-2nd Grade Girls:

- NAVY BLUE JUMPER - Length should be at least mid-calf.
- BLACK CLOSED TOE SHOES
 - This does not include slip-on clogs, shoes, sandal, etc.
 - The heels may not exceed 1 inch.
 - Heeles are not allowed.
- WHITE, FULL SLEEVE SHIRT must be worn by students.
 - No turtle-necks shirts or button-down shirts
 - (HALF SLEEVE SHIRTS may be worn by the KG and 1st grade girls only.)
- SOCKS
 - Must be plain black or white only
- NAVY BLUE or BLACK CARDIGAN (Knitted) sweater
 - Only button-down or pull-over sweater
 - No hoods allowed, no ponchos, mini-sweaters, sweatshirts, etc.
 - Must not have any logo, emblems, etc.
- WHITE SCARF
 - Must be plain, no self-prints, designs, logos or trimmings
- NAVY BLUE PANTS
 - Loose fitting pants to be worn under the jumper
 - No jeans & sweat pants

➤ KG-2nd Grade Boys:

- NAVY BLUE PANTS
 - Loose fitting pants
- BLACK CLOSED TOE SHOES
 - This does not include slip-on clogs, sandal, etc.
 - Heeles are not allowed.
- WHITE, POLO-STYLE FULL SLEEVE SHIRT must be worn by students.
 - No turtle-necks shirts or button-down shirts
 - HALF-SLEEVES may be worn during the warm weather
 - Must wear a white undershirt underneath the uniform shirt
- SOCKS
 - Must be plain black or white only
- NAVY BLUE or BLACK CARDIGAN (Knitted) sweater
 - Only button-down or pull-over sweater
 - No hoods allowed, no sweatshirts, etc.
 - Must not have any logo, emblems, etc.
